JUNE 15™

<u>PAYCHECK PROTECTION PROGRAM (PPP)</u>

President just signed the Paycheck Protection Program Flexibility Act,
which relaxes some of the original restrictions of the program, including:
Extending the time frame to use the loan from 8 weeks to 24 weeks;
Reducing the 75/25 rule on payroll costs to 60/40; and
Pushing back the deadline to rehire laid-off workers from June 30 to December 31, 2020.

SMALL BUSINESS GRANT

The New Jersey Economic Development Authority (NJEDA) announced that Applications for Phase 2 of the Small Business Emergency Assistance Grant will be available on June 9, 2020 at 9:00 a.m.

The \$45 million program will provide grants up to \$10,000 to small businesses impacted by the coronavirus pandemic.
